



Enhancing support for Roma people with physical disabilities to access health structures and benefits (RomInDis)

OVERVIEW OF THE PROJECT

The Roma Health Mediators for Inclusive Access (RomInDis) is an Erasmus + project, a European-funded initiative that aims to strengthen cooperation between Roma Health Mediators(RHM) and Health Professionals(HP), so as to improve healthcare access for Roma people that face mobility impairments.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- ✓ Improve the access Roma PWPDS to health structures, care services & benefits;
- ✓ improve the knowledge & capacities of RHM & HP on disability, discrimination, and support of Roma PWPDS & enhance their cooperation to provide support to Roma PWPDS;
- ✓ create & promote innovative policy recommendations for Roma PWPDS health care measures while actively involve Roma PWPDS & capitalize on their living experience;

- ✓ raise awareness on social inclusion Roma PWPDS & break disability taboos.

PROJECT RESULTS

- ✓ Increased updated knowledge of policy makers & HPs on data on the situation of Roma PWPDS, existing policies;
- ✓ Increased upskilling opportunities & capacities of RHM & HPs in relation to their collaboration to provide optimal support, care & benefits to Roma PWPDS;
- ✓ Increased involvement of Roma PWPDS in policy debate design & advocacy for policies & measures that meet their needs & build on their experience;
- ✓ Awareness raising of stakeholders & targeted promotion of project deliverables.



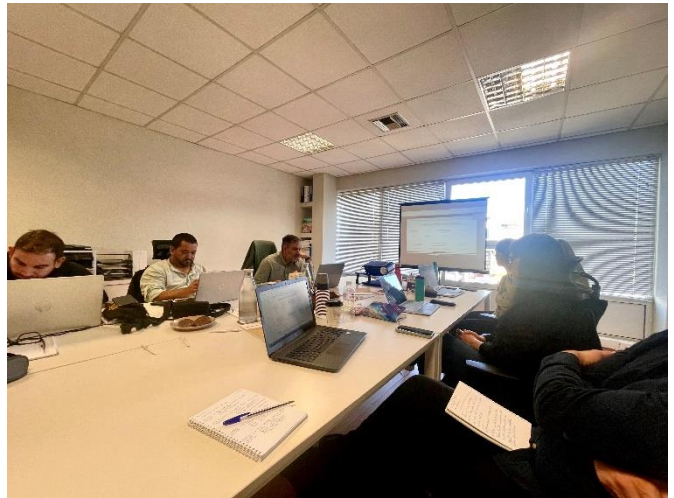

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KICK - OFF MEETING

The RomInDis consortium held its first kick-off meeting in Athens, Greece, in November 2025.

At this 1st meeting, the partners have the chance to get to know each other better, and build cooperation which will improve cooperation and friendship that will contribute to a better and smoother implementation of the project. For the partners that was not able to attend in F2F meeting, they have the opportunity to attend the meeting via Zoom platform, and to give their inputs.



At the meeting, there was a brief presentation of the project by the lead partner, and all partners had the opportunity to present the work packages (WPs) for which they are the lead organizations. The first day concluded with a social dinner, providing an informal setting for networking and relationship building among partners.

The meeting fostered lively discussions, idea exchange, and strengthened collaboration across the consortium. Partners clarified responsibilities, shared best practices, and aligned next steps to ensure successful project implementation.

UPDATE

Currently, all partners have finished with the implementation of the Validation Activities in their country and have developed a corresponding national validation report, which will present the required changes for the outlines of the 2 Capacity Building(CB) programmes as well as the findings on the knowledge and skills of the HP and RHM to be covered by the CB programmes, and the good practices and tools that can be embedded in the outlines of the CB programmes.

Our partner Symplexis as an expert in the design of professional CB programs and as a specialist in the validation activities of the partnership will review the implementation of the validation activities of all partners and will compile the data and information from the national reports to develop a final transnational report available in 7 languages (EN, DE, EL, ES, SE, RO and MK), which will include the proposed changes to the 2 CB programme outlines and the findings on the knowledge and skills of HP and RHM to be covered by the CB programmes, and the good practices and tools to be embedded in the CB programme outlines.
